Group gives shelter \$1,600 raised in Eichelberg ride

A check for \$1,600 was presented to Hope's Haven from the St. Joe Landing campers' second annual Lorna Eichelberg Memorial Ride over the weekend.

Mrs. Eichelberg died last year and the campers wanted to do something to celebrate Lorna's life. Bill Eichelberg, owner of St. Joe Landing, hosted the memorial rides, and Jimmy and Brenda Potter as well as Pat and Lisa Morris organized each year's ride.

The 2017 ride was Sept. 2 and was followed by a pot-

luck. Mrs. Morris coordinated the sale of the T-shirts and hoodies, which netted \$1,600 this year, doubling last year's sales of \$800, which was also donated to Hope's Haven. This donation will be used for veterinary expenses (\$16,208 last year).

"Lorna and Bill have supported Hope's Haven for many years. There are a number of can collection bins around the campground, and the Eichelbergs have donated truckloads of cans to the shelter for recycling. Their efforts on behalf of animals is so greatly appreciated," Sharon Jensen said.
